MS. OUIDED BOUCHAMAOUI 2015 NOBEL PEACE PRIZE LAUREATE

In 2013, Ms. Bouchamaoui worked with the Tunisian General Labour Union to launch the National Dialogue Initiative. Together with the League of Human Rights and the Tunisian Order of Lawyers, they formed the Tunisian National Dialogue Quartet. The Quartet was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 2015 for its contribution to the building of a pluralistic democracy in Tunisia in the wake of the Jasmine Revolution of 2011.

Ms. Bouchamaoui was the first woman to serve as President of the Tunisian Union of Industry, Trade and Handicrafts from 2011 to 2018. She is recognized as one of the most influential businesswoman in Africa. In 2017, Ms. Bouchamaoui was elected Vice President of the European Center for Peace and Development.

In 2019, Ms. Bouchamoui joined France's Advisory Council for Gender Equality at the invitation of President Emmanuel Macron. In addition to advocating for gender equality and her work as a peacebuilder, Ms. Bouchamaoui serves as a shareholder and administrator of the Hedi Bouchamaoui Group.
